

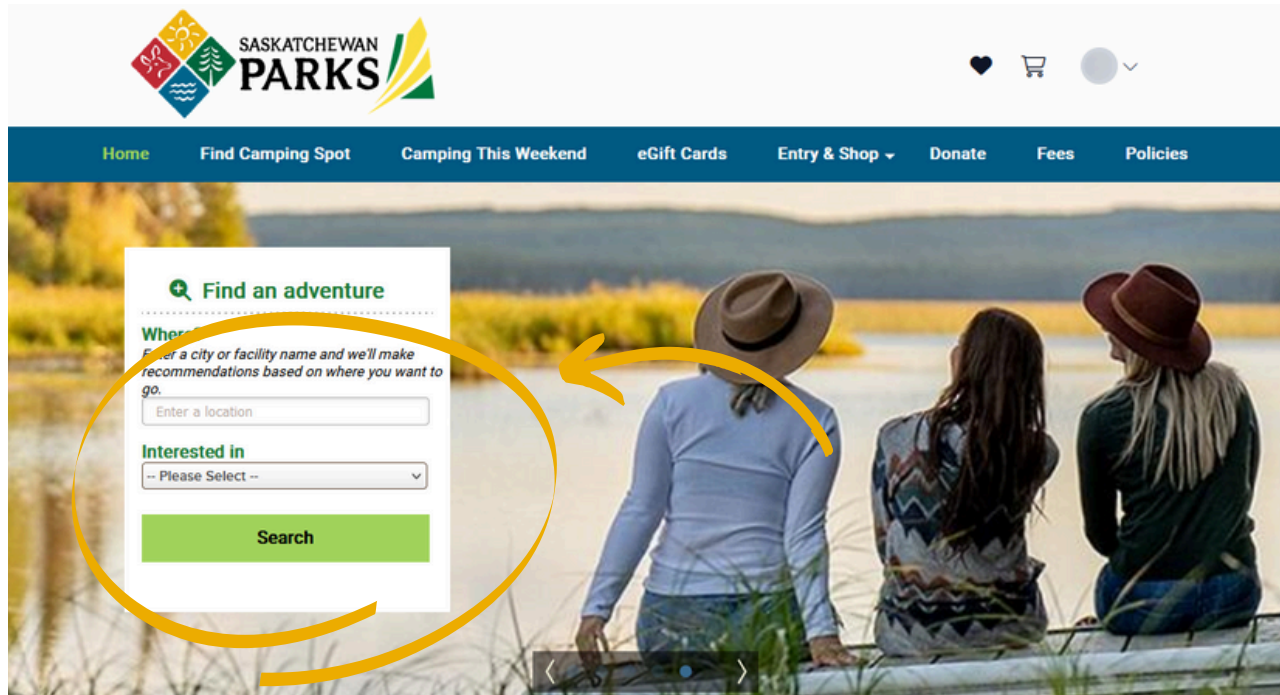
# NIGHTLY RESERVATIONS

## A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

### Step 1

Enter your park of choice, arrival date, and length of stay.

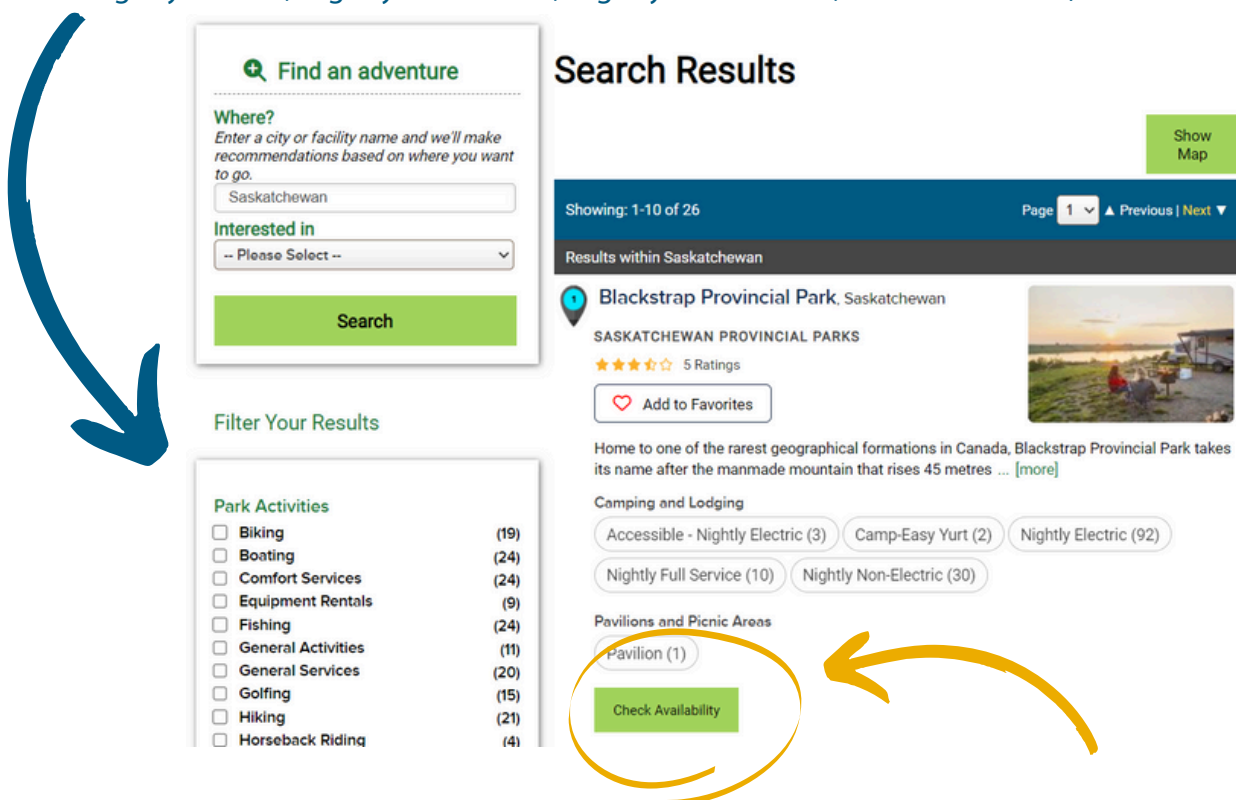
Tip: If you want to see all provincial parks enter "Saskatchewan" or leave location blank and all parks will be listed alphabetically.



### Step 2

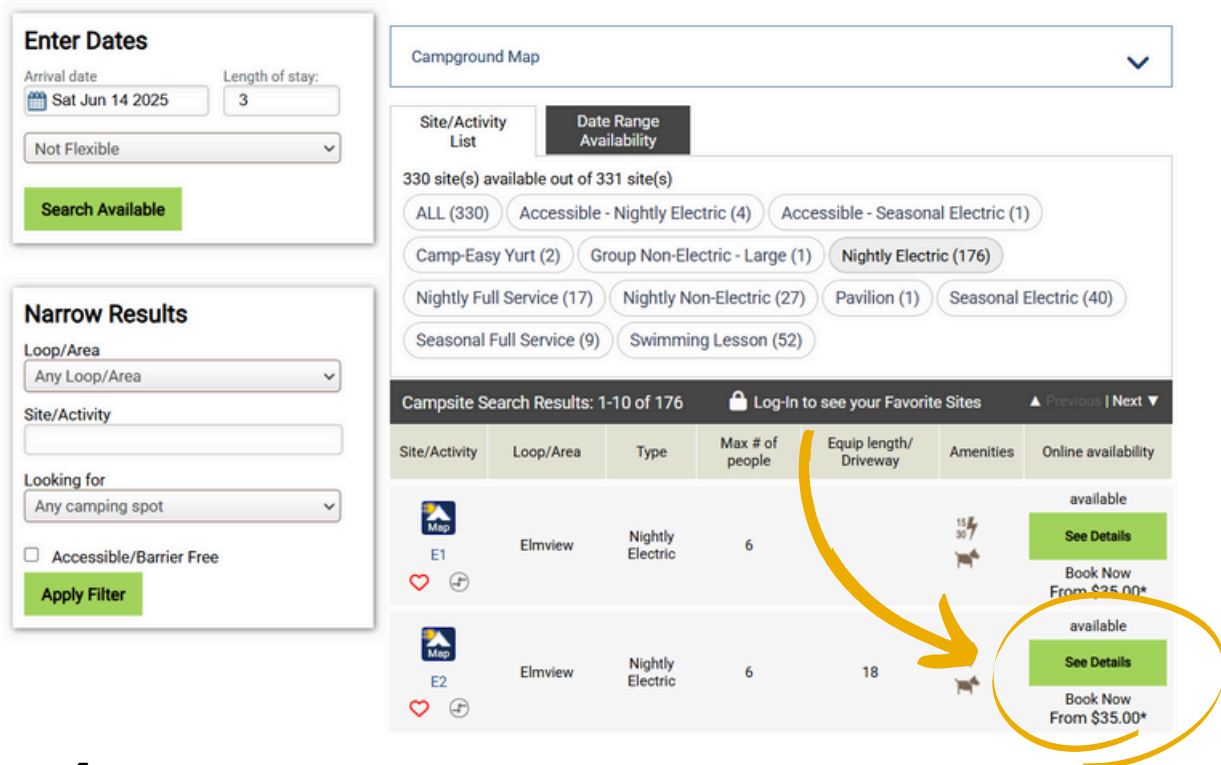
Select "Book Sites" or "Check Availability"

Tip: You can use the filters to refine your search more to your needs (i.e. Camp-Easy Tent, Nightly Electric, Nightly Full Service, Nightly Non-Electric, Seasonal Electric)



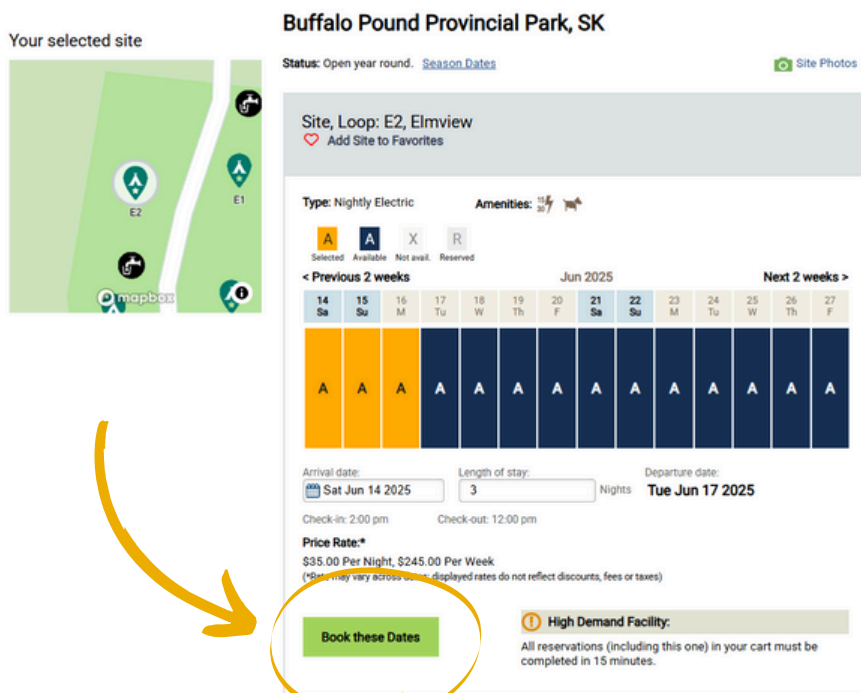
### Step 3

Select the campsite of your choice by clicking "See Details" or "Enter Date". It will take you to the campsite detail page.



### Step 4

At this step, you will be able to view all campsite details, confirm your dates, and then select "Book these Dates".

### Alerts and Important Information

#### Park

Please read the following terms and conditions for visiting Saskatchewan Provincial Parks:

- A valid vehicle entry permit is required on all vehicles while in a provincial park. Entry can be purchased in advance of your arrival by visiting [parks.saskatchewan.ca](https://parks.saskatchewan.ca)
- If you purchased an annual vehicle entry permit online, it will be mailed to the mailing address associated with your reservation (allow a minimum two weeks for delivery).
- Permit holders are responsible for the conduct and behavior of their family and guests and must ensure all camping permit rules and regulations are being met.
- If you have an annual vehicle entry permit and a reservation, you can proceed directly to your campsite. You will be automatically checked in.
- Permit holders shall not rent, sell, sublet, assign or otherwise transfer their reserved campsite to another occupant.
- Pets are welcome in all our parks and must be on a leash no longer than two meters. Owners are responsible for the behavior of their pets at all times and must clean up after their pets. Pets are not allowed in public facilities or on the beach unless it is a designated pet friendly area.
- Consumption or display of an alcoholic beverage or cannabis in a public space is prohibited. Alcoholic beverages and cannabis may be consumed in the camping permit holder's camping unit, and on their assigned campsite.
- To report park emergencies, enforcement or wildlife concerns, call Park Watch at 1-800-667-1788 (available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week).
- You are responsible for adhering to all of Saskatchewan Provincial Parks policies, rules and regulations. For more information see [parks.saskatchewan.ca](https://parks.saskatchewan.ca)

#### Saskatchewan Provincial Parks Policies and Rules

- We accept Visa, Mastercard, Visa Debit, Mastercard Debit, and Sask Parks eGift Cards as payment methods for reservations made online at [parks.saskatchewan.ca](https://parks.saskatchewan.ca) or through the Sask Parks Reservation Call Centre (1-833-775-7275). Prepaid credit cards, cheques, and cash are not accepted for online payments.
- A \$12 reservation fee is applied to each separate reservation booked. The reservation fee covers the cost of administering the reservation service. An additional \$2 surcharge will apply to all transactions using the Call Centre.
- You may change or cancel your reservation by visiting [parks.saskatchewan.ca](https://parks.saskatchewan.ca) or by calling the Saskatchewan Provincial Parks Reservation Call Centre at 1-833-775-7275.
- Reservation, change and cancellation fees are non-refundable.
- Where a refundable damage deposit is required, this must be paid in full at the time of reservation. If no damage occurs during your stay, you will be refunded the damage deposit.
- Change and cancellation penalties are based on the type of site reserved and outlined under Fees and Policies on [parks.saskatchewan.ca](https://parks.saskatchewan.ca). If a change or cancellation is not covered by these penalties, Saskatchewan Provincial Parks will apply the relevant transaction/penalty charges if you:
  - Shorten any dates on a reservation.
  - Change arrival date, except to extend a reservation by arriving earlier.
  - Downgrade to a lower-priced site or activity.

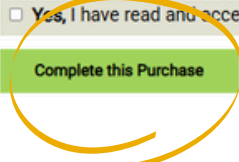
