
# **HOW TO BOOK SWIMMING LESSONS**

## Step 1


Go to parks.saskatchewan.ca, hover over the profile icon in the top right corner, and click "Sign In / Sign Up"




## Step 2

In the "Find an adventure" box, use the following filters:

- Where? Swimming lessons are offered at Pike Lake Provincial Park, Buffalo Pound Provincial Park and Cypress Hills Interprovincial Park.
- Interested in: Camping & Swimming
- Looking for: Swimming Lessons
- Arrival date: can be left blank if you are unsure, or enter in a Monday date in June, July or August.
- Length of stay: enter 5
- Click search!




You will then see a listing of the parks offering swimming lessons. Click "Book Sites" at the park you wish to book swimming lessons for.




## Step 4

Please read the following terms and conditions for visiting Saskatchewan Provincial Parks:


- A valid vehicle entry permit is required for all vehicles while in a provincial park. Entry can be
- a digital or printed copy of your entry permit.

  If you purchased an annual vehicle entry permit online, it will be mailed to the mailing address
- associated with your reservation (allow a minimum two weeks for delivery).
- Permit holders are responsible for the conduct and behavior of their family and guests and must ensure all camping permit rules and regulations are being met.
- Quiet time is 24 hours a day.
- If you have a valid vehicle entry permit and a reservation, you can proceed directly to your campsite. You will be automatically checked in.
- Permit holders shall not rent, sell, sublet, assign or otherwise transfer their reserved campsite to another occupant.
- Pets are welcome in all our parks and must be on a leash no longer than two meters. Owners are responsible for the behaviour of their pets at all times and must clean up after their pets. Pets are not allowed in public facilities or on the beach unless it is a designated pet friendly
- Consumption or display of an alcoholic beverage or cannabis in a public space is prohibited. Alcoholic beverages and cannabis may be consumed in the camping permit holder's camping unit, and on their assigned campsite.
- To report park emergencies, enforcement or wildlife concerns, call Park Watch at 1-800-667-1788 (available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week).
- You are responsible for adhering to all of Saskatchewan Provincial Parks policies, rules and regulations. For more information see parks.saskatchewan.ca [2].






# **Step 8**Review your purchase and click "Checkout Shopping Cart".

Saskatchewan Provincial Parks Policies and Rules

- · We accept Visa, Mastercard, Visa Debit, Mastercard Debit, and Sask Parks eGift Cards as payment methods for reservations made online at parks.saskatchewan.ca or through the Sask Parks Reservation Call Centre (1-833-775-7275). Prepaid credit cards, cheques, and cash are not accepted for online payments.
- A \$12 reservation fee is applied to each separate reservation booked. The reservation fee covers the cost of administering the reservation service. An additional \$2 surcharge will apply to all transactions using the Call Centre.
- You may change or cancel your reservation by visiting parks.saskatchewan.ca 🚨 or by calling the Saskatchewan Provincial Parks Reservation Call Centre at 1-833-775-7275.

Reservation, change and cancellation fees are non-refundable.

- Where a refundable damage deposit is required, this must be paid in full at the time of reservation. If no damage occurs during your stay, you will be refunded the damage deposit.
- Change and cancellation penalties are based on the type of site reserved and outlined under Fees and Policies on parks.saskatchewan.ca 📮 If a change or cancellation is not covered by these penalties, Saskatchewan Provincial Parks will apply the relevant transaction/penalty charges if you:
  - Shorten any dates on a reservation.
  - Change arrival date, except to extend a reservation by arriving earlier.
  - Downgrade to a lower-priced site or activity.
