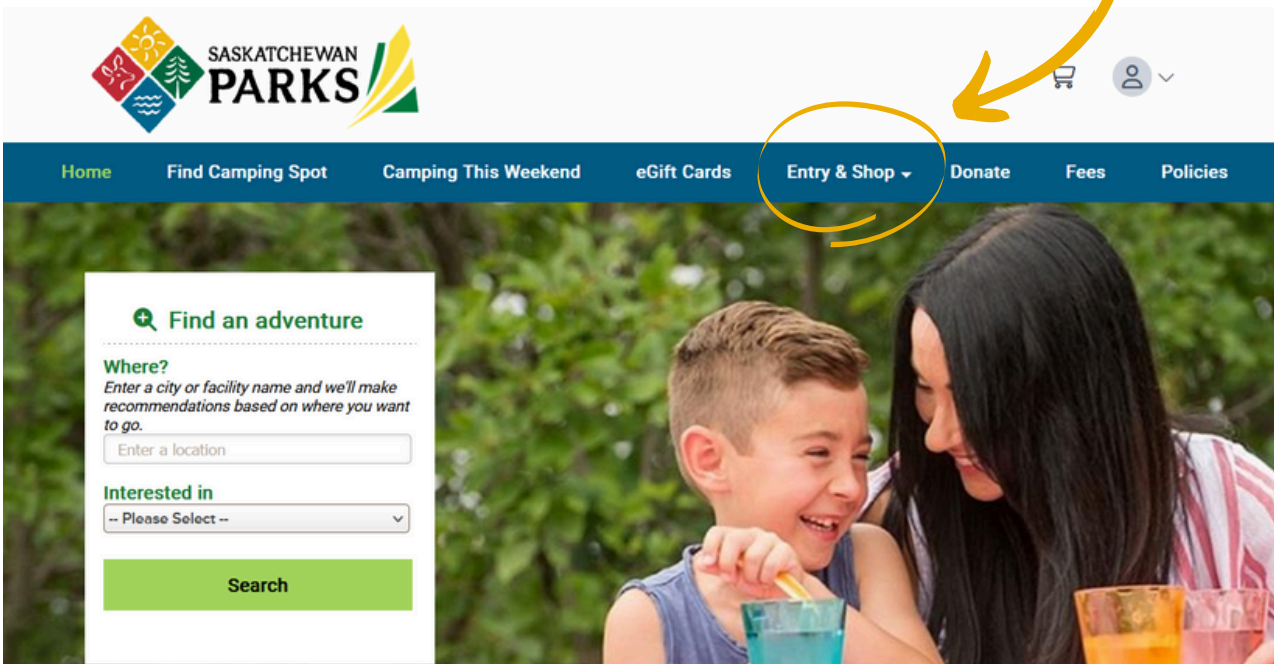


PURCHASE A STANDALONE PARK ENTRY PERMIT

A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

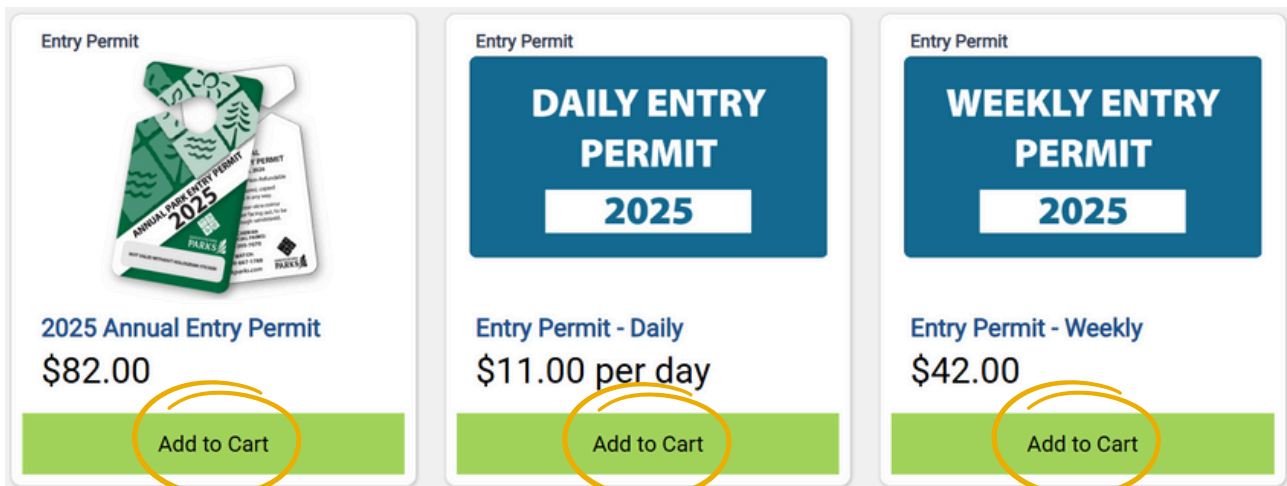
Step 1

In the top blue banner, hover over “Entry & Shop” and click “Entry Permits”




Step 2

Click “Add to Cart” under the type of permit you would like to purchase



Step 3a - Weekly and Daily Entry Permits Only

Review the details of your entry permit, and fill out the information required. Confirm and click "Add to Cart"



Entry Permit - Daily

A Vehicle Entry Permit is required year-round in all Saskatchewan provincial parks. Permits are charged on a per vehicle basis and visitors are required to carry or display proof of purchase when arriving at the park either by having a digital or printed copy of their entry permit.

- A valid Vehicle Entry Permit purchased at one Saskatchewan Provincial Park can be used at all provincial parks.
- Recommended for stays of 1-3 days.
- Valid from time of arrival to 2 p.m. the following day.
- Valid permit can be upgraded to a weekly or annual at the park. Expired permits cannot be upgraded.
- Lost, stolen, or damaged passes will not be refunded or replaced.
- Not transferable between vehicles.
- Saskatchewan residents 65 or older can receive a free entry permit with valid Saskatchewan identification. Available in-park only.
- Stand-alone daily and weekly entry permits are non-refundable, however, valid permits may be reissued to facilitate a correction to permit dates or vehicle licence plate information in advance of the permit start date. This request can be made in advance of arrival by emailing parks_info@gov.sk.ca or upon arrival at the park. Changes are not permitted after the permit start date.

2025 Annual Entry Permit

Annual vehicle entry permits are a great way to ensure you can enjoy Saskatchewan Provincial Parks year round.

- A valid vehicle entry permit is required for all vehicles while in a provincial park.
- Annual vehicle entry permits are valid until April 30, 2026.
- Lost, stolen, or damaged passes will not be refunded or replaced.
- Recommended for stays over 7 days.
- Saskatchewan residents 65 or older can receive a free entry permit with valid Saskatchewan identification. Available in-park only.

Saskatchewan Provincial Parks Policies and Rules

- We accept Visa, Mastercard, Visa Debit, Mastercard Debit, and Sask Parks eGift Cards as payment methods for reservations made online at parks.saskatchewan.ca or through the Sask Parks Reservation Call Centre (1-833-775-7275). Prepaid credit cards, cheques, and cash are not accepted for online payments.
- A \$12 reservation fee is applied to each separate reservation booked. The reservation fee covers the cost of administering the reservation service. An additional \$2 surcharge will apply to all transactions using the Call Centre.
- You may change or cancel your reservation by visiting parks.saskatchewan.ca or by calling the Saskatchewan Provincial Parks Reservation Call Centre at 1-833-775-7275.
- Reservation, change and cancellation fees are non-refundable.
- Where a refundable damage deposit is required, this must be paid in full at the time of reservation. If no damage occurs during your stay, you will be refunded the damage deposit.
- Change and cancellation penalties are based on the type of site reserved and outlined under Fees and Policies on parks.saskatchewan.ca. If a change or cancellation is not covered by these penalties, Saskatchewan Provincial Parks will apply the relevant transaction/penalty charges if you:
 - Shorten any dates on a reservation.
 - Change arrival date, except to extend a reservation by arriving earlier.
 - Downgrade to a lower-priced site or activity.

Step 5

You will now receive a confirmation email to the email address associated with your account.

- If you purchased an Annual Entry Permit, it will be mailed to the address associated with your account or entered during purchase.
 - Campers will be emailed a temporary permit that can be printed and displayed in their vehicle until the Annual Entry Permit arrives. The temporary permit is valid for 3 weeks from date of purchase.
 - A mailing fee of \$1 will be charged per Annual Entry Permit purchased online.
